Subject: Regarding rationalization of tele-medicine services in Himachal Pradesh.

Sir,

In supersession of guidelines issued vide this office letter No. NHMHP-HWC0TRG/1/2019 HWC-11904-2008 dated 10.3.2022 on the subject cited above it has been decided to streamline the tele-consultation services in the state of Himachal Pradesh as follows:

1. The specialist available in the districts in various hospitals such as ZH/RH/DH/CH/and CHCs would provide Tele- Consultation Services to Medical officers of the PHC-HWC. The Tele- Consultation would be provided on all working days including second Saturdays from 11:30 AM to 3:00 PM.
2. Initially Medical Specialist, Paediatrician, Gynaecologist, Dermatologist and Psychiatry will give provide tele- consultations to the MO PHCs-HWC. The districts would map the specialist to the MO PHC based upon the availability of the specialist in the district. The specialist would provide tele- consultation using the existing hardware in the health institution. Equipment provided under Hospital Management Information System may also be used for the purpose.
3. The patient will remain present during the tele- consultation. The patients requiring tele- consultations who report to a PHC before 11:30 AM would be thoroughly worked out and necessary investigations on the patients

must be carried out till 11:30 AM

4. The existing 7 tele-hubs in the Medical Colleges would provide tele-consultations Services to the specialists of the districts. The districts would remove the mapping of PHCs with tele-hubs of Medical Colleges. They would further map the specialist in various ZH/RH/DH/CH and CHCs with the corresponding specialists of the Medical Colleges. The provision of contingency funds @ Rs. 30,000 per month for tele-hubs in Medical Colleges, hereby stands withdrawn.
5. The MO-PHCs would keep on providing tele- consultation to the CHOs of HSC-HWC as is being done presently.


You are requested to ensure that the guideline are adhered to strictly.
