In supersession of all previous notifications regarding Performance Linked Incentives for CHOs and Team Based Incentives for HWC team at HSCs/PHC/UPHC, it has now been decided to disburse Performance Linked Payments (PLPs) and Team Based Incentives (TBIs) as follows:

Health Sub Center-Health & Wellness Center (HSC-HWC) and Co-located HSCs with Primary Health Center- HWC (PHC-HWC) and Urban Primary Health Center –HWC (UPHC-HWC)

- 1. Level of Incentive Distribution
 - a. HWC team at SHC- HWC: Community Health Officer, Multi-Purpose Workers (Male & Female) and ASHAs.
 - b. HWC team at Co-located HSC of PHC/ UPHC-HWC: Multi-Purpose Workers (Male & Female) and ASHAs.
- 2. Incentive amount
 - a. At HWC-HSC
 - Maximum of Rs 15,000/CHO/month as PLP
 - Rs. 3000/month for MPWs (Subject to a maximum of Rs 1500/month/MPW (F&M) as TBI
 - Rs 5000/month for ASHAs (Subject to a maximum of Rs 1000/month/ASHA) as TBI.
 - b. At Co-located HSC with PHC/UPHC-HWC
 - Rs 3000/month for MPWs (F&M) (Subject to a maximum of Rs 1500/month/MPW (F&M) as TBI
 - Rs 5000/month for ASHAs (Subject to a maximum of Rs 1000/month/ASHA) as TBI.
- 3. Based upon verifiable Performance Linked Incentive indicators as per Table-1.
- 4. A team member would only be eligible for incentive if benchmark is achieved as given in the Table-1
- 5. Frequency of distribution: Monthly.
- A performance report of the HSC-HWC team member would be submitted by the CHO to MO-PHC. In case MO-PHC is not in position, the CHO will submit the same to the concerned BMO.
- A performance report of the co-located HSC team members would be submitted by the MPW to the MO-PHC. In case MO-PHC is not in position, the MPW will submit the same to the concerned BMO
- 8. The MO-PHC will submit the performance report received from CHOs/ MPWs to the BMO on the day of scheduled Block Monthly Meeting.

- The BMO will access the received data/record/ reports from various sources of verification mentioned against each indicator and validate the performance report submitted by the CHO/MPW.
- 10. The BMO will verify the submitted reports and accordingly disburse the PLP & TBI to the HWC team within 1 week of the block meeting every month.
- 11. The BMOs will submit a consolidated report of PLPs & TBIs disbursed in the previous month to the District on the day of District Monthly Meeting.
- The CMOs will submit a consolidated report of the district to the state headquarter within a week of the District Meeting.
- 13. These PLPs & TBIs would be applicable from the month of May, 2022 onwards.

Team Based Incentives for Medical Officer & Pharmacist PHC / UPCH-HWC

1. Level of Incentive Distribution

Medical Officer of PHC/ UPHC-HWC

Pharmacist of PHC/UPHC-HWC

2. Incentive amount

Rs. 6915 per month per MO as TBI

Rs. 1500 per month per Pharmacist as TBI

- 3. Based upon verifiable Performance Linked Incentives indicators as per Table-2 & 3.
- A team member would only be eligible for incentive if benchmark is achieved as given in the table-2 & 3
- 5. Frequency of distribution: monthly
- A monthly performance report of PHC/ UPHC-HWC would be submitted by MO to the BMO on the day of Block Monthly Meeting.
- 7. The BMO will access data/record/ reports from various source of verification mentioned against each indictor and validate the performance report submitted by the MO.
- The BMO will verify the submitted reports and accordingly disburse the Team-Based Incentives to the HWC team at PHC/ UPHC within 1 week of the Block Meeting every month.
- 9. The BMO will submit a consolidated report of TBIs disbursed for the previous month to the district on the day of District Monthly Meeting.
- The CMO will submit a consolidated report of the district to the state headquarter within a week of District Meeting.
- 11. These team-based incentives would be applicable from the month of July, 2022 onwards.
