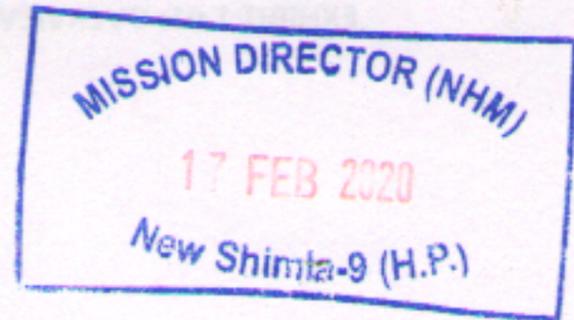

A. Equipments and supplies for NRC:

1. Glucometer
2. Digital thermometers (preferably low-reading)
3. Digital weighing scales for indoor ward
4. Outpatient and Pediatrics Emergency area
5. Infantometer for OPD and NRC ward
6. Stadiometer (to measure standing height)
7. Resuscitation equipments and Suction equipment.
8. IV stands
9. Storage almirah
10. Room heater for NRC ward
11. Audio visual material LED TV
12. Toys for structural play (Safe, Homemade toys can be used as well)
13. Clock
14. Reference height and weight charts required by Pediatrician and Nutrition counsellor

B. Kitchen equipments & supplies :

1. Cooking source
2. Dietary scales
3. Measuring jars
4. Electric Blender (or manual whisks),
5. Water Filter
6. Refrigerator
7. Utensils (large containers, cooking utensils, feeding cups, saucers, spoons, jugs etc.)
8. Supply for making Starter and Catch up Diet like Dried Milk powder
9. Fresh whole milk
10. Puffed rice
11. Vegetable oil
12. Foods similar to those used in home (for teaching/use in transition to home foods) Will vary, depending on local sources.
