The Governor of Himachal Pradesh is pleased to constitute the Block Level TB Mukh Bharat Committee with the objective of achieving a TB Mukh Bharat through saturation of TB screening coverage among vulnerable populations, early detection of every TB case, implementation of nutrition interventions to ensure successful treatment outcomes, scaling up preventive interventions and promoting community engagement through Jan Bhagidari at block level. The composition of the Block Level TB Mukh Bharat Committee is as follow:-

Chairperson: - Sub Divisional Magistrate / Block Development Officer.

Member Secretary: - Block Medical Officer.

1. Sub- Divisional Ayurvedic Medical Officer
2. Inspector labour and Employment.
3. Panchayat Inspector.
4. Health Educator/ Sr. most Health Supervisor of health department
5. Principal, GSSS-Block HQ.
6. Drug Inspector of concerned Block.
7. Prominent Private Medical Practitioner.
8. My Bharat Coordinators(5 no to be nominated by Chairperson)
9. TB Champions of the block(to be nominated by BMO).

The Terms of Reference (ToRs) of the Block Level TB Mukh Bharat Committee are enclosed as Annexure-I. The Committee shall conduct monthly review meetings to assess the progress of all key activities under the TB Mukh Bharat initiative and review achievements, challenges and the status of implementation in the block.

Terms of Reference (ToR) Annexure-I

Block Level TB Mukht Bharat Committee

1. Designate dedicated Class-1 officer for each administrative ward to undertake various activities under TB Mukht Bharat.
2. Lead, motivate, and supervise the **TB Mukht Bharat Abhiyaan Team** comprising five MY Bharat volunteers and five NCC cadets assigned to the Block/Ward for achieving TB Mukht status.
2. Prepare a monthly micro-plan and weekly activity schedule for awareness generation, community mobilization, TB screening support, follow-up, and reporting, with clear allocation of responsibilities among team members.
3. Convene at least one weekly review meeting with team members and relevant frontline functionaries, document action points, and ensure timely follow-up on pending issues.
4. Coordinate with the District TB Officer (DTO), Block Medical Officer (BMO), Medical Officers, ANMs, ASHAs, Anganwadi Workers, Panchayati Raj Institutions (PRIs), Urban Local Bodies (ULBs), educational institutions, and youth platforms to ensure convergence of TB elimination activities.
5. Organize and facilitate TB awareness activities such as rallies, street plays (Nukkad Natak), poster and wall-writing campaigns, IEC dissemination, school and community meetings, and verified social media campaigns to counter myths, misinformation, and stigma related to TB.
6. Undertake supportive supervisory field visits at least once every week during campaign periods to verify activities, resolve local issues, and provide guidance to team members and front line workers.
7. Ensure timely documentation of activities, including photographs, attendance records, field visit notes, outputs, and outcomes, while maintaining the dignity, consent, and confidentiality of TB patients.
8. Verify that all relevant activities and outcomes are captured in the prescribed reporting formats/portals and submitted to district

authorities within stipulated timelines.

9. Identify implementation gaps, logistical constraints, and support requirements related to IEC, TB screening, and community mobilization, and promptly escalate such issues to the District Committee/Administration.
10. Liaise with local institutions, resident welfare groups, employers, schools, colleges, self-help groups, and other stakeholders to mobilize community participation and support.
11. Engage with the TB Mukht Bharat Abhiyaan as a **Nikshay Mitra** and support patient-centric initiatives, including voluntary distribution of nutrition baskets to TB patients.
12. Enroll and participate in Experiential Learning Programmes (ELPs), quizzes, and other activities available on the MY Bharat Portal to strengthen understanding and engagement with the TB Mukht Bharat Abhiyaan.
13. Reinforce key public health messages on **Swachhata (Cleanliness)**, including *No Spitting*, cough etiquette, infection prevention, sanitation, and hygiene practices to reduce TB transmission.
14. Promote **Nasha Mukti** messages by encouraging people to avoid drugs, alcohol, smoking, and tobacco use, thereby reducing the risk of TB.
15. Facilitate TB prevention awareness among household contacts, vulnerable populations, and the wider community.
16. Promote the use of the **TB Mukht Bharat App** and **Khushi Chatbot** to improve community awareness and knowledge regarding TB prevention, diagnosis, and treatment.
17. Support health workers in mobilizing community members for TB screening camps and Ayushman Arogya Shivirs.
18. **Specific role of NCC Cadets:** Undertake community awareness generation, regular outreach, field monitoring, and actively support TB screening camps and Ayushman Arogya Shivirs by remaining present in full ceremonial uniform and assisting health workers in mobilizing community participation.
