Terms of Reference (ToR) of Members

Annexure-I

District TB Mukht Bharat Committee

1. Chairperson – Deputy Commissioner / Additional Deputy Commissioner

- **Chair monthly District TB Mukht Bharat Committee meetings.**
- **Provide overall leadership and monitor district TB elimination progress.**
- **Ensure convergence of all government departments.**
- **Review district performance and resolve implementation challenges.**
- **Guide implementation of the TB Mukht District Action Plan.**

2. Co- Chairperson – Chief Medical Officer

- **Coordinate implementation of district TB elimination activities.**
- **Ensure availability of human resources, diagnostics and treatment services along with Hand held X-ray and NAAT Machines.**
- **Monitor achievement of district targets.**
- **Submit progress reports to the State TB Cell on monthly Basis.**

3. Convener – District Tuberculosis Officer

- **Convene committee meetings and prepare the agenda.**
- **Present district TB performance and action plans.**
- **Coordinate implementation with all departments.**

- *Monitor screening, diagnosis, treatment, TPT and nutrition support.*
- *Follow up on committee decisions.*

4. District Youth & Sports Officer (MY Bharat Coordinator)

- *Mobilize MY Bharat volunteers for TB awareness campaigns.*
- *Support community screening and IEC activities.*
- *Organize rallies, youth campaigns and village awareness drives.*
- *Promote volunteer participation in TB Mukat Bharat activities.*

5. NCC/NSS Group / Unit Commander

- *Engage NCC cadets in awareness campaigns.*
- *Support community mobilization, rallies and outreach activities.*
- *Promote TB awareness among educational institutions.*
- *Assist during special screening campaigns.*
- *Provide psycho social support and counselling to People with TB (PwTB) to improve treatment adherence and overall well-being.*
- *Strengthen diagnosis and management of complicated TB cases.*
- *Coordinate with the District NTEP Team to ensure smooth reporting of fixed X-ray screening data from Medical Colleges and facilitate timely sharing of indoor ward TB screening data with the concerned NTEP officials.*
- *Ensure participation of faculty in capacity building and mentoring.*
- *Support operational research and programme reviews.*
- *Facilitate referral services and specialist consultations.*

7. District Panchayat Officer

- *Coordinate the implementation of the TB Mukat Panchayat Initiative across all Gram Panchayats and ensure that the TB Mukat Panchayat agenda is included in every PRI meeting at the District, Block, and Gram Panchayat levels.*
- *Ensure Gram Panchayats display TB IEC materials.*
- *Facilitate Gram Sabha discussions on TB.*
- *Promote GPD support for TB awareness activities.*
- *Monitor TB Mukat Panchayat certification activities.*

8. District Labour and Employment Officer

- *Ensure that Ayushman Arogya Shivirs (TB Screening Camps) are organized in*

industries and that all workers are screened for TB at least once every quarter.

- *Coordinate TB screening among industrial workers, labourers, and migrant workers.*
- *Facilitate TB awareness programmes at workplaces and ensure the display of TB IEC materials at all workplaces.*
- *Facilitate linkage of vulnerable workers to TB diagnostic, treatment, and preventive services under NTEP.*
- *Promote occupational health awareness, including TB prevention and early health-seeking behaviour among workers.*

9. District Education Officer (Secondary)

- *Promote TB awareness in schools.*
- *Organize school awareness sessions and competitions.*
- *Display IEC materials in educational institutions.*
- *Encourage student participation in TB campaigns.*

10. District Ayurveda Officer

- *Mobilize AYUSH institutions for TB awareness.*
- *Refer at least 5% of presumptive TB cases to NTEP facilities.*
- *Support community IEC and preventive health promotion.*
- *Participate in Ayushman Arogya Shivers.*

11. Assistant Drug Controller/Drug Inspector

- *Sensitize private pharmacies and chemists to refer presumptive TB cases to the nearest health facility and promote timely TB notification under NTEP.*
- *Monitor compliance with Schedule H1 regulations for anti-TB drugs.*
- *Promote timely referral of presumptive TB patients from private pharmacies to NTEP health facilities for diagnosis and treatment.*
- *Generate TB awareness through private pharmacies by printing TB awareness messages on medicine bags and displaying TB symptom IEC materials prominently at pharmacy stores.*

12. President, Indian Medical Association (IMA)

- *Mobilize private practitioners for TB notification.*
- *Promote adherence to Standards for TB Care.*
- *Encourage private sector participation in TPT and TB screening.*
- *Support CMEs and capacity-building programmes.*

13. District Programme Officers (NTCP, NCD, AIDS, Child Health and other Health Programmes)

- *Ensure convergence with respective health programmes.*

- *Integrate TB screening with programme activities.*
- *Facilitate referral of presumptive TB cases.*
- *Support awareness and reporting activities.*

14. Representative of Local NGO / CSO

- *Mobilize community participation.*
- *Conduct IEC and stigma reduction activities.*
- *Support treatment adherence and nutrition linkage.*
- *Assist in identifying vulnerable populations.*
