Regarding preparedness for Dengue & other Vector borne diseases under NVBDCP for the year 2023.

Sir/Madam,

As you all know that every year there is an upsurge in dengue cases and seems few cases of other vector borne diseases in Himachal Pradesh. To prevent any outbreak & to keep the situation under control it is requested to take the below mentioned presumptive measures before the onset of dengue & other vector borne diseases.

1 Prevention and control measures :

- [a] Vector control.
- [b] Outdoor Fogging/Indoor Residual Spray
(IEC material & Integrated Vector management guideline already sent to all CMO's/DPOs through email on dated 23.01.2023).
Surveillance to be intensified.

2 IEC Activities:

- [a] Print (implications of non compliance of Dengue Notification under Epidemic diseases act)
- [b] Social media.
- [c] Radio
- [d] IEC at all levels (VHSC/Schools/Anganwaris/ Gram Sabhas/Mahila Mandals/Yuva Mandals (mobilization of NSS/NCC cadets in campaigns) Panchayats.
- [e] Folk Media through Public Relations Department.

3. Community involvement Activities :

- [a] social mobilization.
- [b] Swachthaa Abhiyan.
- [c] Involve NGO's local Social workers/community leaders/ & PRI's
(For active community involvement for environmental management in vector control).

4 Co- ordination with other departments :

- [a] PRI at district and block & Panchayat level .
- [b] Rural Development & Urban development authorities.
- [c] IPH /DRDA /soil conservation/fisheries etc.
- [d] Industries Department/ Association of Industrialists & trade unions.
(kindly educate about action that can be taken for violating Dengue Notification under Epidemic Diseases Act 1898).
- [e] ICDS.
- [f] PWD/ HIMUDA and builders.

5 CME /Capacity Building of Medical Officers/Health Supervisors/ Health educators/ ASHA and Health Workers.

6 Logistical support : Medicines/ Formats / transportation/ larvicidals/ insecticides/medicines.

7 Human resource at all levels/ RRT/ help can be taken from District Administration/ civic bodies
