Subject: - Regarding clarification on RBSK fund utilization under FMR A.5

Sir,

It has been observed by higher authorities that the booking of RBSK procedure expenditure is not as per the Gol guidelines. Most of the booking of RBSK funds is under Medical conditions or partial treatment of Surgeries both of which are not reimbursed by Gol under ROP.

List of conditions (Annexure 1), which requires no surgical intervention and only appropriate medical management, attached. Treatment under such conditions needs Laboratory investigations and Drugs/ medicines. For all medically managed conditions, laboratory investigations are to be booked under free diagnostics, and Medicines to be covered under free medicines as per EDL.


Medical Superintendents of all Hospitals and Medical colleges in state should ensure that expenditure on all medically managed conditions is not booked under RBSK.

List of conditions (Annexure 2) which need surgical interventions are attached. The total cost under package as mentioned in the RBSK manual of Gol (**"PROCEDURES AND MODEL COSTING FOR SURGERIES" RBSK June 2014.**) is inclusive of total cost (on Surgery procedure, hospital stay, laboratory investigations, imaging investigations, drugs, consumables and implants for each package).

Medical Superintendents of all Hospitals and Medical colleges in state should ensure that mentioned surgical conditions are to be booked under RBSK code A.5.2. and Under no condition, the total amount booked should exceed the Gol guidelines **"PROCEDURES AND MODEL COSTING FOR SURGERIES" RBSK June 2014.**

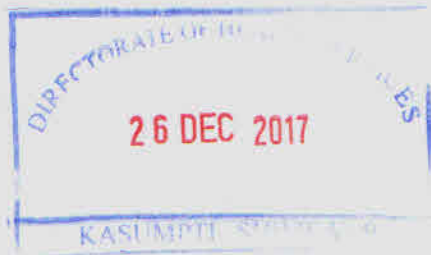
In few surgical conditions, where only investigations are done but no full surgical care is provided (like Congenital Heart disease, Neural tube defect, Cleft lip etc.) expenditure should be booked under RBSK only as per actual to be reimbursed to RKS on raising the verified bills.


All the Utilization Certificate submitted by the Medical Superintendent should have signed statement that **"No funds are collected /raised from individuals (Patients) towards the procedure before and after" before claims settlement is made for each case.**
