**Subject: Revised guidelines under Janani Shishu Suraksha Karyakaram-
JSSK**

Sir/Madam,

As you are aware, to address issues like high out of pocket expenditure on diagnostics/investigations, blood, drugs, food and user charges in institutional delivery, JSSK was launched in June 2011 to eliminate out-of-pocket expenses for institutional delivery of pregnant women and treatment of sick infants. This was also envisaged that free treatment shall increase the institutional delivery rate and contribute to the goal of safe motherhood. With the advent of the Ayushman Bharat-Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana and HIMCARE, there is a duplication in the management of high risk pregnancies and caesarean sections. In order to optimally utilize the benefits of all the schemes, the following guidelines should be followed by all the public health institutions providing services for high risk pregnancies and caesarean sections:

1. The expenditure for the following high risk deliveries and C-sections may be claimed under Ayushman Bharat - Pradhan Mantri Jan Aarogay Yojana and HIMCARE Health Insurance schemes for the beneficiaries who are registered in these schemes:

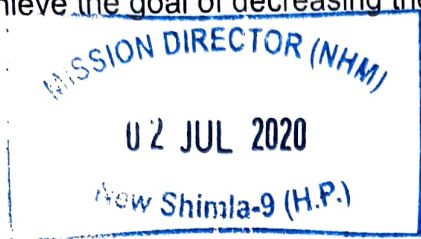



- The expenditure for all the conditions which are not covered in the above mentioned table in respect of beneficiaries of Ayushman Bharat - Pradhan Mantri Jan Aarogay Yojana and HIMCARE Health Insurance schemes and due to be provided free of cost under JSSK, may be booked under the relevant FMR code under JSSK through PFMS.
- Similarly, for the expenditure incurred towards providing free services under JSSK for all the beneficiaries who are not covered under Ayushman Bharat - Pradhan Mantri Jan Aarogay Yojana and HIMCARE Health Insurance

schemes, the booking may be done under the relevant FMR code under JSSK through PFMS.

These guidelines must be followed rigorously for optimal utilization of all schemes and to achieve the goal of decreasing the maternal and infant mortality rates.


