Subject: Financial assistance under Janani Suraksha Yojana - Plus (JSY-Plus) scheme, revised guidelines thereof.

Sir/Madam.

In supersessions of the instructions issued vide this office earlier letter No. HFW-H/JSY(2006)-Vol.1 dated 20/12/2017 and letter No. NHMHP-MTH0JSY/1/2019 dated 17/12/2019 regarding financial assistance under Janani Suraksha Yojna Plus (JSY Plus) scheme, the guidelines for financial assistance have been revised as follows:

- The detail of all the eligible beneficiaries of JSY Plus including Bank Account No. duly linked with Aadhar No. would be uploaded on the RCH portal by the concerned health functionary, for eg. Health worker, health Supervisor etc.
- 2. The Block Medical Officer will ensure that the details of all such JSY Plus beneficiaries are updated on the RCH portal at the earliest, not later than 24 weeks of pregnancy in such a manner that there are no duplicate entries.
- 3. The PFMS portal will automatically verify the details of the JSY Plus beneficiary.
- 4. Any health institution where the delivery takes place would upload



the outcome on the RCH portal and disburse the financial benefit to the beneficiaries through DBT immediately after the delivery.

- 5. In case of delivery of a patient claiming to be a JSY Plus beneficiary, who is not registered on the RCH portal, the health institution, where delivery has been conducted may register the beneficiary on the RCH portal and fill the outcome.
- 6. The payment to the Claimant will only be made after verifying all the details of the claimant.
- 7. The Incharge of the institution shall ensure that the payment is disbursed to the eligible ladies who had institutional delivery in public health facility before the discharge of the patient from the respective institution.
- 8. In case of the Home Delivery of BPL women, concerned Block Medical Officer/Chief Medical Officer to ensure that financial benefit are disbursed to the beneficiaries through DBT within ten days of the delivery.

The financial norms of disbursement of incentives under the "JSY Plus" scheme along with the FMR codes is tabulated as under:

	Institutional Deliveries in case of BPL,SC,ST belonging to Rural Areas	Rs. 1100
